Highway Improvements

What is happening

We are pleased to inform you that we will be carrying out structural improvement works on the canal bridge situated on the A530 Baddington Lane, Nantwich and will take approximatley 8 days to complete, commencing on 31 July 2021. Under current Health & Safety legislation and for the safety of our workforce and members of the public, it will be necessary for the road to be closed at all times during the works.

We understand there is no right time to undertake this work however, the scheme has been carefully planned to minimise disruption to local residents, businesses and members of the travelling public.

When it's happening

The works are programmed to begin on 31 July until 08 August under a 24 hour closure, including weekends

Please note that occasionally the works have to be changed at short notice due to unforeseen circumstances such as adverse weather conditions or logistics.

Access to your property or business



We aim to minimise disruption to local residents and business ownwers whilst we deliver these improvements. We will make every effort to maintain vehicular access to your property or business however, it is inevitable that some inconvenience will occur and there may be periods of time when point of entry will vary. If you have any specific access requirements, please raise these with our on site supervisor at the earliest opportunity.

Your safety and the safety of our workforce is our primary concern. Therefore, Traffic Management Officers supplied with CCTV cameras will be present during the works to assist you as the site operations progress .
